The Role provides an alternative and complimentary source of primary healthcare alongside services traditionally provided by a General Practitioner.

Mental Health Practitioner Role

The role combines advanced Mental Health nursing skills with clinical, diagnostic and treatment skills.

They have a prescribing qualification and are able to prescribe within their own clearly defined remit.

The Mental Health Practitioner provides assessment and treatment of patients 17 years and over. Children must be seen by a GP.

In order that you can be directed to the most appropriate clinician for your query please do not be offended if reception ask you the reason for your call.
