A clinical pharmacist has a detailed knowledge of medicines and their uses and is able to prescribe.

The Role provides an alternative and complimentary source of primary healthcare alongside services traditionally provided by a General Practitioner.



Clinical Prescribing Pharmacist Role

The role combines that of a traditional pharmacist who has specialist knowledge about medication as well as training to examine, diagnose and treat patients.

They have a prescribing qualification and are able to prescribe within their own clearly defined remit.

Pharmacists support the other practitioners in the practice with specialist information about medications and alternatives.

What can an Clinical prescribing Pharmacist Help with?

- √ Information and advice to patients on medication queries
- √ Annual Medication reviews
- √ Changing medication following test results or hospital instructions
- √ Changes in medication following long term conditions clinics
- √ Treatment of minor ailments and injuries

In order that you can be directed to the most appropriate clinician for your query please do not be offended if reception ask you the reason for your call.

You will need to see a GP for the following

- √ Anxiety/ Depression
- √ Sick Notes
- √ Menstrual bleeding, mastitis, breast lumps,
- √ Women's Health
- √ Pregnancy related problems
- √ Headaches
- √ Men's Health (testicular lumps, prostate concerns)
